Pocklington Junior School is an average-sized junior school. Our structure means that we have multiple classes in each year group, allowing teachers to work closely together in year group teams. This collaborative approach is something we value highly, as it enables staff to plan together, share ideas and support one another to provide the very best learning experiences for our pupils.

We are proud to be an inclusive school where every child is valued and supported to succeed. Inclusion sits at the heart of our ethos and is reflected in the way we organise our provision and the care we provide for all pupils. As part of this commitment, we host a school-run Enhanced Resource Provision (ERP) that supports children with high levels of additional need, ensuring they are fully included in the life of the school while receiving the specialist support they require.

Our school continues to grow alongside the town we serve. Recently, we were delighted to welcome two brand new classrooms to our site, built to accommodate the growth of the town. These modern learning spaces provide high-quality environments that support excellent teaching and learning.
